Elections for 2019 officers were held with these results:

Everyone introduced themselves and expressed their collecting interests, including out newest member, **Rene Ferdinand** (worldwide and British Colonials). One Boy Scout and his father visited to continue working on his merit badge and showed a beautiful project he is making for Christmas presents to his grandparents. Each is a framed picture of a country map surrounded by stamps of that country.

Dale Niebuhr showed the LINPEX 2019 cancellation that **David Frye** is working on. It will be submitted to the Post Office for approval. A collage of Nebraska pictures is being worked up as the cachet for the show covers. Dale reported that 6 dealers have now signed up for LINPEX..

Frosty Anderson passed around a magazine article listing the countries with the highest value of mint stamps issued from their #1 through 2018. The valuation used 80% of catalog value for all stamps valued at less than \$1,000. The USA topped the list at over \$348,000.

LaVonne Uffelman showed a book on Noah's Ark with an image of a Noah's Ark stamp issued by the Vatican. LaVonne recognized the stamp from **Kurt Meyer's** Vatican stamp program at our previous meeting.

Mark Sellhorn showed a 1940 cover cacheted with Wendell Wilkie promising to deflate FDR's run for a third term as President.

December 20 PROGRAM Member show/tell items relating to the year of their birth; high school graduation; marriage; and/or retirement.

Dale Niebuhr showed the final proposal for the cachet made by **David Frye** for the LINPEX show covers of a collage of Nebraska pictures along with the write up for the cover insert. **Dave Wallman** reported that 7 dealers have now signed up for LINPEX. Dale has contacted the club in Lancaster, PA about the cost of shipping exhibit frames to us. We have 9 frames of exhibits committed, but there is room for more. We want to have at least 16 frames for LINPEX. Please consider exhibiting—its non-competitive, just for fun.

Dale talked about the meetings coming up. We will have member buy/sell nights, DVD's on stamp subjects, and **Keith Riese** will have a program on Pitcarin Island stamps.

LaVonne Uffelman brought in a small Christmas tree that her granddaughter had decorated with all different US Christmas stamps.

Some club members brought in items from their collections for the year they were born, graduated from high school, married, and/or retired.

Dale Niebuhr– Born 1953 -German stamp remembering POW's honoring his father who was a POW in WWII and a founder of our Lincoln Stamp Club.
Graduated 1971 – German stamp celebrating the 100th anniversary of the German Empire
Married 1974 – German stamp celebrating the 25th anniversary of the German Federal Republic.
Retired 2014 – German stamp celebrating the 175th anniversary of establishing kindergartens.

LaVonne Uffelman – Born 1949 – Swedish, British, NATO stamps reflecting her heritage and snowflake stamps reflecting her being born in a snowstorm. Also a listing of events and the birth of famous people the same year.
Graduated 1967 – Nebraska statehood stamp, Vietnam stamps because of the war.
Married 1973 – Love stamps (self-explanatory) and a collection of sport stamps because she likes all sports

Joel Johnson – Born 1942 – 1991 Twinsburg, OH cover that his father had cancelled on Joel's birthday with his twin sister.

Geoff Duncombe – Born 1936 – a collection of Winston Churchill stamps and pictures of VE day in London, May 8, 1945 because he was there to see Churchill and the King and Queen. He talked about the air raids, gas masks, and seeing a V-1 rocket flying overhead.

Keith Riese – Born 1948 – U.S. Sc. 948 CIPEX souvenir sheet.
Graduated 1966 – U.S. Sc.1311 SIPEX souvenir sheet
Married 1970 – U.S. Sc. 1387-1390 block of animal stamps
Retired 2014 – a collection of Pitcarin Island stamps and the latest issue of the Pitcarin Island study group newsletter.

Kurt Meyer– Born 1966 – U.S. Sc. 1313 celebrating 1000 years of Christianity in Poland.

Mark Sellhorn – Born 1950 – plate block of U.S. Sc. 989 for the national capital sesquicentennial used on a special delivery cover
Graduated 1968 – German cover for the Mexico City Olympics advertising the 1972 Munich Olympics
Married 1974 – cover showing the Senate's vote of approval for Nelson Rockefeller as President Ford's Vice President and awaiting the vote of the House of Representatives.

Martin Luther King, Jr.

Martin Luther King, Jr. was a social activist and Baptist minister who played a key role in the American civil rights movement from the mid-1950s until his assassination in 1968. King sought equality and human rights for African Americans, the economically disadvantaged and all victims of injustice through peaceful protest. He was the driving force behind watershed events such as the Montgomery Bus Boycott and the 1963 March on Washington, which helped bring about such landmark legislation as the Civil Rights Act and the Voting Rights Act. King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 and is remembered each year on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, a U.S. federal holiday since 1986.
