The incoming officers were installed. The cachet and cancellation made by **David Frye** for the LINPEX show covers along with the write up for the cover insert were shown. Both will go to the printers. **Dave Wallman** reported that 8 dealers have signed up for LINPEX. The news release was finalized and will be forwarded to Meekels and Linns. Posters will be available at the next meeting. We are in contact with the club in Lancaster, PA about shipping exhibit frames to us and **LaVonne Uffelman** has agreed to store the frames. It was reported that 17 frames are now signed up for exhibits at LINPEX. With the acquisition of frames, we discussed the need for a \$5/frame fee for exhibiting and decided to keep the fee.

We talked about the meetings coming up: #1's of the World (DVD) at the next meeting; Feb 7 will be a workshop to put stamp packets together; Feb 21 will be LINPEX prep and a quiz; Mar 21 will be Vatican City by **Kurt Meyer**; and April 18 will be Pitcarin Islands by **Keith Riese**.

**Rene Ferdinand** passed around a collection of older postcard showing the capital and other places in Lincoln.

**Mark Sellhorn** showed a 1940 postcard from Daytona Beach to Denmark with a Nazi censor stamp.

### January 17

We talked about the survey recently sent out. Information will be compiled and presented at the next meeting. **Dave Wallman** reported that 8 dealers have signed up for LINPEX and a 9<sup>th</sup> dealer has requested a space. The floorplan can be worked out to accommodate him, so we will contact the new dealer and a new floorplan will be worked out. Show covers will be ready for the next meeting. The news release and posters are being put out. **Joel Johnson** has arranged to be on TV during the week of LINPEX to advertise the stamp show. The exhibit frames will be coming and **LaVonne Uffelman** has volunteered to store them. 19 frames are now signed up for exhibits at LINPEX. We still need titles and descriptions for each to put in the program.

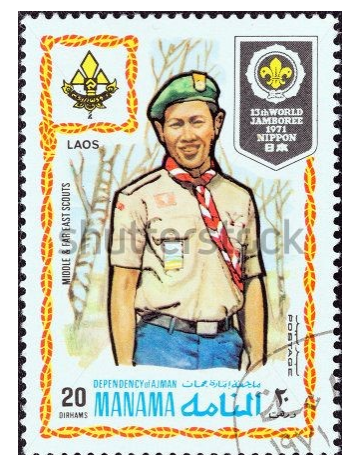
**Dale Niebuhr** passed around pictures of LINPEX from 1971 and 1966, including Dale as a young member of Lincoln Stamp Club.
