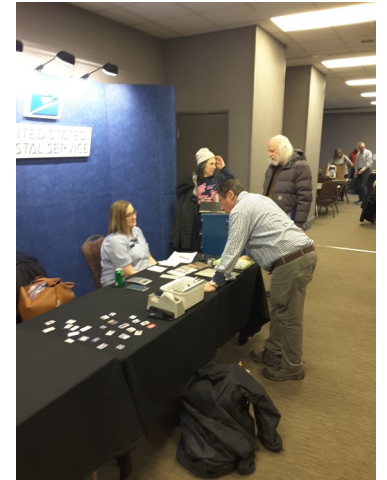
We reviewed preparations for LINPEX 2019.

The International Red Cross was formed in 1863 by Swiss-born Henry Durant.

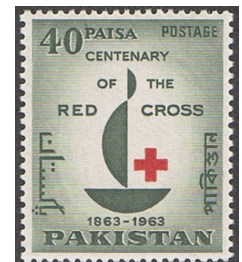
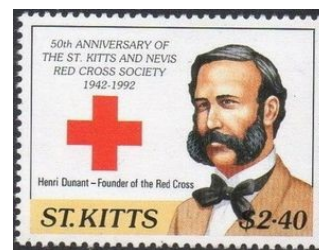
