# USPS HONORS NEBRASKA'S SESQUICENTENNIAL: STAMP SHOWS SANDHILL CRANES ON THE PLATTE

The United States Postal Service honored millennia of Nebraska's prehistory by selecting an iconic photograph of sandhill cranes searching for their evening shelter along the Platte River. A ceremony, held Wednesday, March 1, in the Rotunda of the Nebraska Capitol Building featured the stamp's unveiling and remarks by Michael Forsberg, photographer.

He briefly described the effort and patience needed to make the photograph and then noted how the photograph captures the crossing of the cranes' south-to-north migration and the river's west-to-east flow. The river also marks the path taken by people of all cultures who have traversed the prairie, traveling eastward and westward across Nebraska.



**Reflections:** Michael Forsberg, renowned nature photographer and Nebraska resident, described his approach to making the photograph of the sandhill cranes flying over the Platte River in central Nebraska that the USPS chose for the stamp's design. **Audience:** Several Club members arrived early to get front-row seats. ## LINPEX 2017: Nebraska Sesquicentennial

For two days—February 25 and 26, 2017—the stamp-collecting public and Club members mingled over dealers' wares, tubs of loose stamps from the United States and around the world, covers new and old, and treasures of unknown value retrieved from attics at LINPEX, the annual show featuring an array of resources that proved attractive to collectors of diverse interests.

The U.S. Postal Service provided the pictorial show cancel highlighting Nebraska's 150th anniversary of statehood and offered selections from its current stamp releases. The University of Nebraska Press brought a wide selection of its titles with Nebraska themes.

- applied the show cancel to one of the Club's cacheted covers.












# CLUB PREPS COVERS FOR COLLECTORS
