August 17 PROGRAM: BLUE theme member show and tell:

Keith Riese showed his collection of blue Hungary and DDR stamps.

Dave Hamilton presented a variety of Tonga covers and gave a history of tin can mail.

Geoff Duncombe presented his Great Britain 2 pence blue stamp and a history of Rowland Hill, its creator.

Dave Wallman showed blue post office uniform badges, a sheet of the July 1, 1971 USPS stamp and a first day presentation of the Nebraska Territory stamp with a variety of cancellations.

Larry Spreeman showed a collection of Seagram's Cinderella stamps with interesting information on each of the first 48 states.

Joel Johnson brought in a blue 2c revenue stamp used on an 1877 Claremont NH cancelled check.

Gene Crump showed a collection of Black History postcards; a multi-autographed FDC of the new Nebraska stamp; and 1975 US commemoratives.

Mike Ley showed his collection of blue Finland stamps on cover 1924-54, and presented a history of their usage, especially postwar 1945.

Dale Niebuhr showed his collection of colorful post-1990 German semi-postal stamps.
