John Schultz agreed to continue as our auction manager, but stressed that he is running out of material and seriously needs donations or private listings. Nolan Sellhorn showed a Chinese souvenir sheet from his dinosaur collection and a sheet of the new Disney villain stamps he bought at the Omaha Stamp Show.

Mark Sellhorn passed out a November calendar from the Spellman Museum showing a stamp related to each day.

Bob Ferguson worked through a reconciliation of the Scott numbering system on US stamps explaining the variations in how stamps are numbered.

An auction followed the meeting.

November 16:

We passed out LINPEX exhibit forms and reviewed the floorplan for LINPEX. Space is available for another dealer, we will contact one. PROGRAM:

The Life and Work of Czeslaw Slania, Part 2 by Bob Ferguson

Czeslaw Slania (Ches-wav Swan-ia) was born in 1921, but did not engrave his first stamp until he was 29 years old. Over his lifetime, Slania engraved 1,070 stamps for 44 different countries. Being a highly-talented master at his craft, each stamp is truly a work of art. His ability to reproduce exacting shapes and shades in a piece of steel the size of a tiny postage stamp, and to produce those images rather quickly, made Slania the world's premier stamp engraver. Most of his work was on Swedish and Danish stamps, although he was commissioned to do 9 US stamps. Using high quality digital images, Bob took us through the last three decades of Slania's life and the beautiful stamps that he produced Some of Bob's favorite engraved stamps and souvenir sheets are on the next page.
