## CLUB HAPPENINGS LAST MONTH:

### June 6: BUSINESS MEETING:

We talked about the APS show in August and passed around a guide to register for the stamp show and sign up for volunteer work. By volunteering to work at least 8 hours, each person will receive a free ticket to the awards banquet (a \$50 value). We will need to man our booth to welcome people to the show, sell show covers and possibly recruit members to our club. .

**Joel Johnson** showed a *LINN'S* article on the cost of buying all of the U.S. stamps in 2018, not counting the cost of buying sheets or coils, and passed around two 1987 covers commemorating the 2/22/21 first night airmail flight.

**LaVonne Uffelman** showed *Keleher's Quarterly* with articles on the 1898 Trans-Mississippi Exposition in Omaha and the upcoming APS show in August.

**Sam Wesley** showed a 1971 Japanese cover marking the 13<sup>th</sup> annual World Scout Jamboree.

**Mark Sellhorn** showed two 1937 The covers with identical cachets marking first flights from Hong Kong to Honolulu and from Honolulu to Macao.

The meeting was followed by members looking through donated items for sale.

### June 20:

We talked about the APS show in August and picked up a guide to register for the stamp show and sign up for volunteer work. We have 6 people signed up to volunteer, but we need to have 6 more. If you volunteer for 4 or more hours in a day, they will pay for your parking. By volunteering to work at least 8 hours, you will receive a free ticket to the awards banquet. We will need to man our booth as well to welcome people to the show, sell show covers and possibly recruit members to our club. A sign-up sheet was passed around for manning our table.

Meetings coming up: no meeting July 4 for the holiday; July 18 will a scavenger hunt; no meeting on August 1 for the opening of the APS show in Omaha; and the August 15 program will be a DVD on doctoring postage stamps.

**Mark Sellhorn** passed around a 1935 registered, insured cover from France to England with 5 wax seals on the back sealing the four corners and the flap..

**Bob Ferguson** presented the program on *"Engraved Stamps of West Africa"*. Through images of engraved stamps, Bob led us through the history of each west Africa colony, its history and current national name. In 1870 it was estimated that 10% of Africa was colonized by European nations, but by 1914 it had become 90%. France, Great Britain, and Germany all produced engraved stamps for their colonies, however Portugal did not. The printing of engraved stamps continued until the late 1960's and early 1970's when other printing methods became more cost effective. Bob's use of enlarged digital images of each stamp impressed us all with the beauty, color and fine detail of these engraved stamps. Some of those stamps are shown on the next page.

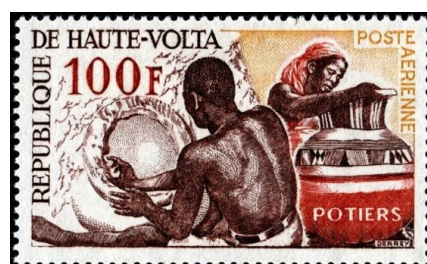

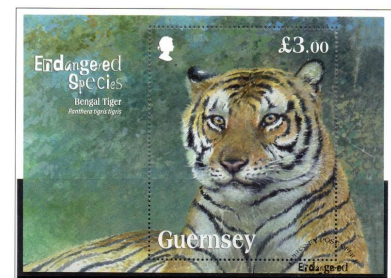
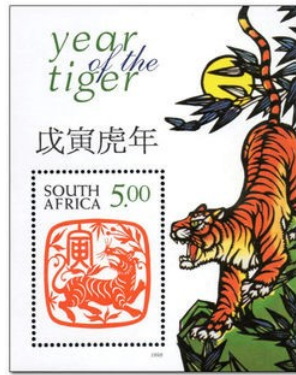
