Mark Sellhorn showed an unused International Reply Coupon issued in 1946.

We reviewed final preparations and publicity for Stamp Collecting Day and talked about the programs for upcoming meetings. It was reported that 2 dealers have already committed to LINPEX 2020.

Joel Johnson showed albums and binders of how he maintains his collections and his system of inventories of what he has and checklists for what he wants.

Dave Wallman showed more covers that he save from work including one with a tied Easter seal; one with 2 pennies taped to it during a rate change; one with a cut out label used as a stamp; and one with eight 3c Conestoga Wagon stamps and thirteen 1c American Kestrel stamps.

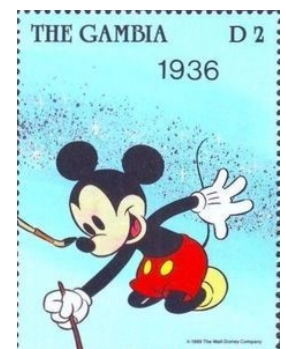
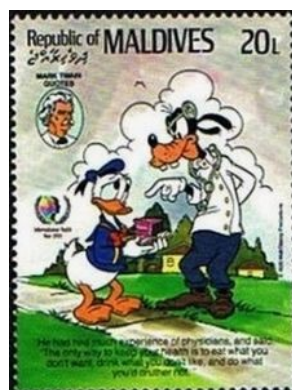
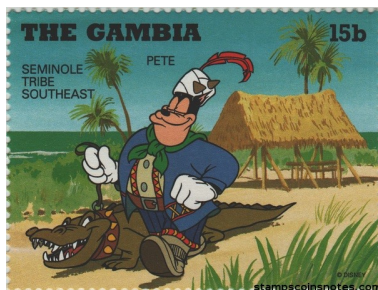
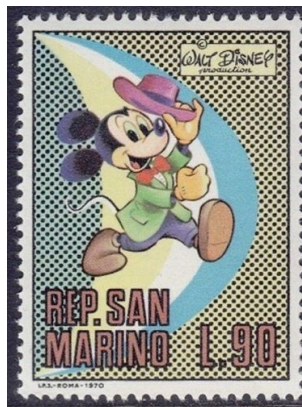
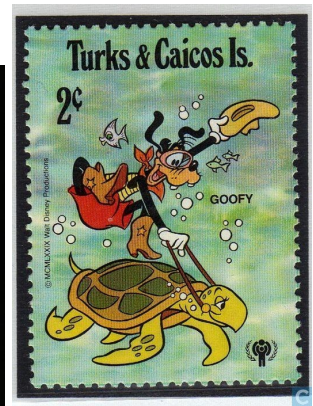
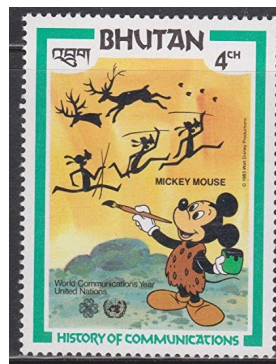
