Just today I responded to an invitation that came to my e-mail inbox almost three months ago. I'm intrigued by the simplicity of Postcrossing's service. According to its Web site, Postcrossing is "... a project that allows anyone to receive postcards (real ones, not electronic) from random places in the world.

For a stamp collector, that shouts out, "Real stamps on real mail from who knows where!" According to the Web site, Postcrossing has 364,846 members from 215 countries with 454,166 postcards currently in the mail. I think it's time to sign up!
