September 17 Meeting

Another virtual meeting on Zoom with members attending from Lincoln, Omaha, Grand Island, Henderson (Nevada), and Venice (Florida). The Adventist Church in College View has decided that we can hold our Stamp Collecting Day in one of their areas, so upon a vote of the members, it was decided to go ahead with Stamp Collecting Day on Sunday, October 18. The flyer is on a following page. We can also hold our in-person meeting there.

Joel Johnson showed a collection and display of the first 20 Christmas stamps that his wife had made for him.

Gene Crump showed several FDC's and sheets from his collection of Black Americans and Black history. He talked about sending in covers for the USPS to send back FDC's for his collections.

Ken Nickerson showed 2 books—*Captain James Cook—The Explorer* with stamps and history and *Intercepted in Bermuda* about the British censoring all mail coming to the Americas from Europe during WWII.

Ron Ecklund showed a variety of Barbados stamps he got in a purchased stash.

Randy Bergstrom showed 2 covers that he received in a purchase of single-use prexie covers. One cover was franked with Sc. C13 and the other with Sc. C15.

Keith Riese showed part of his United Nations flag set consisting of 54 stamps.

Dale Niebuhr showed a color identification booklet and had a short quiz on color abbreviations.

Mark Sellhorn showed a 1922 British postcard with a 2c postage due stamp pre-cancelled Council Bluffs/Iowa.
