Club Happenings Last Month

September 9 Meeting

We met with 18 members attending. After a round of introductions, **LaVonne** talked about Stamp Collecting Day coming up on October 24. Volunteers have already signed up for many of the tasks, but there is always room for more.

Due to a scheduling conflict at the Church, the November meeting will be held on the third Thursday, November 18. The meeting will include an expanded member show and tell. Everyone is encouraged to bring something from your collections to show the club how or what you collect. It doesn't need to be a presentation, just showing something philatelic that you enjoy.

Sandy Lewis passed out face masks that she had made using material with stamp images.

Tom Johnson passed around 3 issues of the U.S. Philatelic Classics Society journal showing the changes from 1951 to 2021.

David Arunski passed around some Schermack privately perforated stamps including one with a control perfin for the Julian Hawthorne Co.

Brad Shay showed a 1999 cover from Tonga to Guam; a 1941 cover from Dallas franked with a 10 c Special Delivery, 10c airmail, and 1c postage due; and a cover from ChicagoPex with a label for World Stamp Expo 2026.

Dave Wallman showed a group of 1974 covers franked with the individual mineral stamps (Sc. 1538-1541) each having a piece of the mineral attached; a large USPS mailer covered with 12c stamps and a "non-compliance" sticker; and a 1982 cover with the Nebraska stamp (Sc. 1979A) and a cachet naming the Western Meadowlark as the Nebraska state bird.

Mark Sellhorn showed a 1932 cover marking a mail delivery flight of the helium-filled dirigible USS Akron and a 1933 cover in memoriam for the 73 lives lost when the USS Akron crashed in April, 1933.
