David Arunski passed around his sets of the 1922-1925 flat plate printing perf 11 stamps particularly comparing Sc. 573 and Sc. 573a.

Don Ehly passed around a copy of the worksheet that he uses to track his inventory/want list.

Marilyn Weidner passed around a 1991 Kiev/USSR cover franked with 3 different USSR stamps.

LaVonne Uffelman showed a fun activity with her name at the top of a paper and under each letter she found stamps that begin with that letter.

Amber Wesley showed a group of junk mail envelopes of different sizes and messages just received and a 1,000-piece jigsaw puzzle of a scene showing the USPS delivering mail.

Brad Shay passed around a 1974 USPS booklet on “Space” and including most of the stamps to full the booklet.

Mark Sellhorn showed the addressed half of a 1855 British cover franked with a 1 schilling embossed stamp (Sc. 5), marked postage due, and addressed to the Secretary of War in Washington DC. Jefferson Davis was Secretary of War in 1855.

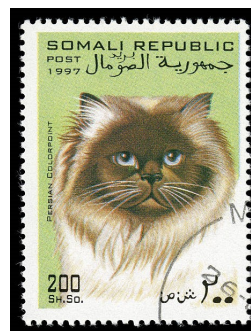
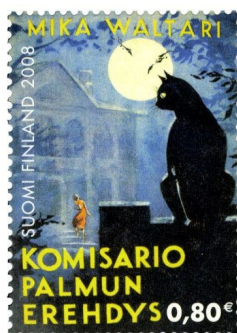
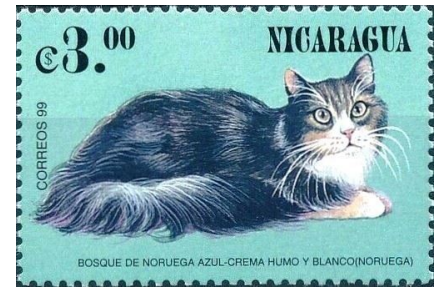
