Club Happenings Last Month

July 14 Meeting

We met with 20 members and one guest, Mark Jetter, attending. We briefly discussed Stamp Collecting Day coming up on October 23. LaVonne began a conversation on LINPEX 2023, typically held the last weekend of February, which would be February 25-26. After discussion, it was moved and seconded to hold LINPEX on those dates and to pursue the use of Country Inn and Suites as in the past. The door prizes of two Apollo 15 FDC's (launch and splash down) were won by Rene Ferdinand.

Amber Wesley passed around the current United Nations bulletin with order form and a White Mountain catalog with several stamp puzzles for sale.

Kurt Meyer passed around items relating to his program last month on the U.S. space program - a listing of NASA national sites available for tours and information on the Cosmosphere in Hutchinson, Kansas.

Brad Shay showed a 1910 Official Business penalty cover from Topeka, KS to Neodisha, MN. The \$300 penalty for unofficial use has remained the same to today.

Cynthia Carlson showed a 1875 cover from Cynthiana, KY and a 1890 cover from Cynthiana, IN. **Cynthia** is still on the lookout for other covers from towns named Cynthiana.

Dave Wallman passed around some stamps he found in donated material. He had two Hitler head German stamps - one overprinted "Ostland" (used in the Baltic countries of Lithuania, Latvia, and Estonia) and another overprinted Ukraine (used in the Ukraine and Poland). **Dave** also showed a precancel from Two Rivers, WI and a perfin "BFG" for the B.F. Goodrich Company.

Mark Sellhorn showed a 1906 leather postcard from Pitcairn, PA to Bedford, PA and franked with a 1 cent Franklin (Sc. 300) and a 1 cent postage due (probably Sc. J38).

The meeting was followed by the sale of items on consignment. The sale was very successful, the family was well pleased, and they donated the remaining items to the club.
