Amber's Promotion of Stamp Collecting Month.

Deciding to personally help promote our hobby during Stamp Collecting Month each October, **Amber Wesely** used a display cabinet in the local library for the month of October in 2018 and has been able to use this display space every year. Amber began by introducing the public to the "tools of our trade" - tongs, hinges, albums, etc. But right away, it was easy to see that everyone liked the stamps, especially the kids. Each year, Amber has changed it up and added to her promotion by making Mystic Stamp catalogs and copies of Topical Times from the ATA available for people to take and having handouts for kids. Amber has continued to expand her annual display by adding other collateral items like a puzzle, books, a toy truck and Fleetwood Proof Sheet portfolios. Then realizing that some folks are isolated, Amber began sending cards, notes and letters to kids to begin with and then added others. Using discounted postage from the club, she uses the mail system to send these fun messages to about 30 people each month.

The club gives Amber two thumbs up for actively using her talents and time to promote the great hobby of Philately to her community.
