Cynthia Carlson passed around a couple of postcards from her Nebraska cancels collection—Germantown and Opportunity.

Tom Johnson passed around a 1920 cover inadequately addressed and marked “This letter delayed because of failure to use correct numeral”.

Brad Shay showed an old Post Office board game; a set of Chinese postcards with pictures using stamps; and a guitar with stamps honoring Queen Elizabeth made by his mother (and club member) **Janet Savage**.

Ken Nickerson showed and donated a large cover franked with 133 stamps.

Kurt Meyer showed a collection of Vatican and Pope stamps that he got at the Omaha Stamp Show.

Stephen Allen passed around an 1861 soldier’s letter w/ cover; a Confederate cover franked with CSA 11-AD; and a pair of covers from Israel.

Mark Sellhorn showed a May 6, 1937 cover posted to Germany to be returned on the Hindenburg, but was returned by surface mail due to the Hindenburg explosion.
