Mark Sellhorn showed three very decorative cacheted covers for the Mayflower stamp (Sc.5524) done by an artist in Cedar Rapids.







October Meeting

Program: *The Prexies*” by **Willie Knopp**

Willie walked us through the 1938 Presidential stamp series (Sc. 803—834) commonly referred to as “prexies”. Beginning with sheet stamps issued in late 1938, coils and booklets followed in early 1939. Willie explained the issuance of the stamps in Presidential order with the then-current half-cent rates filled in with Benjamin Franklin on the 1/2-cent (Sc. 803); Martha Washington on the 1 1/2-cent; Sc. 805); and the White House on the 4 1/2-cent (Sc. 809) values. Willie’s primary focus is on single-use covers for each of the stamps on which only the same denomination stamps are used. In keeping with the Presidential order, several of the stamp denominations were issued but only satisfied complicated and obscure postal rates. Those denominations are difficult to find solely used on cover. Having collected for several decades, many of Willie’s items are rare if not unique. Several of his favorites are shown on the next page.
