### PROGRAM: What does Halley's comet possibly have anything to do with Charlie Brown & the meaning of Christmas ?" By: Kurt Meyer

Kurt related the similarities between the Charlie Brown Christmas special and Halley's comet. In the Christmas special, Charlie Brown bemoans the commercialization of Christmas. However, Linus reminds him that all is well because of the order and predictability in the heavens. Kurt compares that order and predictability to that of Halley's observation of his comet and his prediction of its return. In Halley's time, comets were onsidered random and chaotic. Through scientific means, Halley determined that the comet would return every 77 years plus or minus 2 years. He was correct and established that, just like with Charlie Brown, there is order and predictability in the heavens.
