Program:

Colonial Stamps of Australia, New Zealand, Spain and the U. S. By Bob Ferguson

With the use of his digital images, Bob showed and explained the stamps produced by/for the colonies of Australia, New Zealand, Spain and the United States. As he talked about the stamps from each colony, Bob relayed the history of the colony and its progression toward independence and, in some cases, becoming an independent nation. The stamps of these colonies began with overprints of the mother country's stamps and moved to using stamps displaying their own name. Some of Bob's favorite colony stamps are on the next page. They all add another opportunity to start a new collection.

It was issued by Bolivar, a province of Columbia, in 1863 and is called the Bolivar 10c green.
