We met with 24 members. **Hans and Ruth Kaiser** talked about their experience at the Great American Stamp Show. They were impressed with the great dealers, collectors, and the overall experience. **Ruth** did mention that one of her highlights was having clam chowder every day. **Mike Ley** was the head judge for the show and talked about the process of judging the exhibits. **Tom Johnson** mentioned that in the August issue of the AP Journal, **Mike Ley** received the multi-frame reserve grand for his “Burma— The First Two Issues” exhibit. **Dale Niebuhr** and **Amber Wesely** talked about The American Topical Association (ATA). They encouraged others to join since the club would receive the ATA journal for free if we have six club members belonging to ATA. **Dale** passed out handfuls of covers from the **Edgar Hicks** collection to everyone present.

Brad talked about LINPEX 2025 coming up in February and asked for advance ideas for a theme and possible stamps to use on the show covers. The dates have been picked—Friday, February 28 and Saturday, March 1. Ten rooms have been reserved at the Country Inn and Suites. Stamp Collecting Day will be Sunday, October 20 here at the church. **Brad** passed around a sign-up sheet to help with everything for the day. The October meeting will include the sale of donated material and the November meeting will be a member buy/sell night.

Brad Shay passed around a 1929 wooden cover and letter franked with a 2c Nebraska overprint (Sc. 671).

Amber Wesely talked about the USPS bringing back “Mr. Zip” and passed around Mr. Zip activity books for kids.


Dave Wallman showed some 1976 off-white LINPEX souvenir cards and compared to a sheet of cards printed on blue paper that had never seen before.

Mark Sellhorn showed a set of poisonous mushroom stamps from Kyrgystan and the cover they came in franked with stamps of the Kyrgystan mountain range.

Program: “Exhibiting” by Mike Ley

Mike took us step-by-step on putting together a quality exhibit. Whether we choose to exhibit competitively or just for fun, he showed us that by exhibiting we can learn more about our material and others may give us material since they know what we collect. Mike talked about different ways of displaying our items using hinges, corner mounts and heavier card stock for sheets. Then he covered the layout of the exhibit with a title page explaining what the exhibit is about and the story that it is telling and highlighting the special items. He added that we always need to include something that ends the exhibit. Mike encouraged club members to start with a one-frame exhibit for LINPEX 2025 to fill up the 20 frames that will be available. Along the way you may enjoy your collection more, perhaps learn more about it, and perhaps enhance it.
