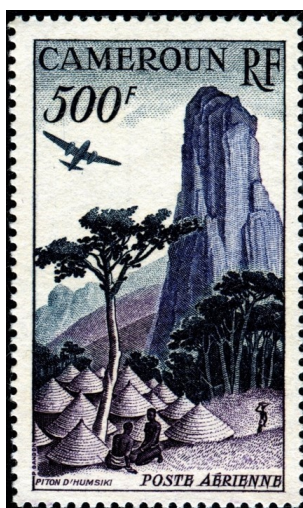
LINPEX 2025
