He read a tribute to postal workers who helped the injured and suffering during the 911 tragedy in 2001. **Brad** then read thru the list of new stamps coming out in the near future and announced that the October program would be by **Mark Sellorn** on “Speeding Up Mail Delivery”

We talked about Stamp Collecting Day coming up on October 19th at the church. **Brad** asked everyone to consider helping in some compacity. Also, we will have a display of past LINPEX covers and programs. We would like as many as possible, so please look thru your collections and let’s have a count at the meeting in October.

**Brad** also brought up that the club will have a joint exhibit at LINPEX 2026. The idea is to have 16 folks each do one sheet for the frame or 32 folks do one sheet for 2 frames. The theme will be World War II since we just celebrated the 80th anniversary of its end. At the meeting, we already had 14 folks sign up, but there is always room for more. This could be a really stellar exhibit.

**Arthur Harper** won a sheet of the 1999 Sonora Desert stamps (sc. 3293).

**Brad Shay** passed around a questionable FDC of the 1c Washington (Sc. 804) dated May 5, 1938. The official first day was actually April 25. A number of possibilities were suggested on how and why this cover was made.

**Tom Johnson** passed around cut squares and envelopes as part of his collection of Washington bicentennial postal stationery showing the various denominations and differences in envelope paper.

**Mike Ley** showed a program and show cover from CENEPEX 89 (annual stamp show of the Central Nebraska Stamp Club in Grand Island, NE). Along with a fair number of dealers and exhibits, there were 8 youth exhibits. Wouldn't that be nice to have at our annual show.

**Henry Sweet** passed around a Tasco booklet, Volume T2, on the 1c issues of 1870-1888. Along with the booklet was a sample of each variety.

**Cynthia Carlson** showed a 1940 cover commemorating the founding of the Jamestown colony and franked with the 5 scientist stamps from the Great Americans series.

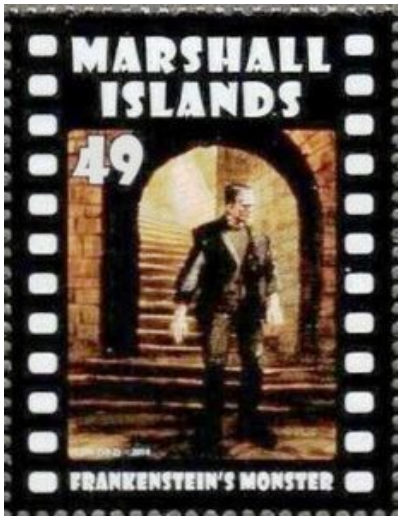
**Mark Sellhorn** passed around a few picture postcards of the view down O street in Lincoln 1908 –1912.
